Please come to our reception honoring these two accomplished young artists.

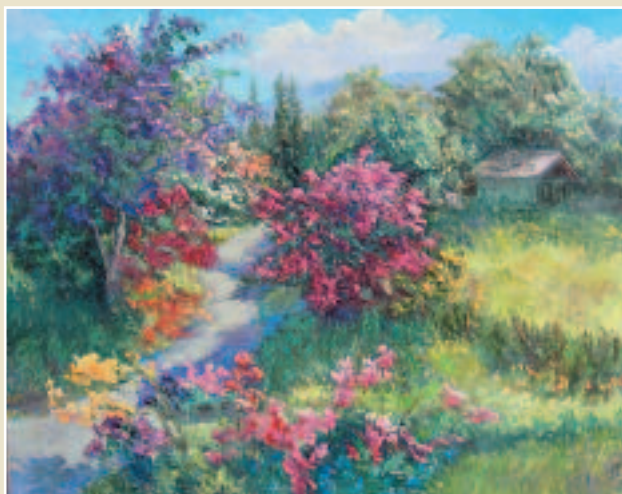

This event is being hosted by Islanders Hawaii Plein Air Painters with the assistance of the LahainaTown Action Committee and The Ritz-Carlton, Kapalua. Maui No Ka Oi magazine will provide coverage in the magazine and website.

Beginning on Sunday, Feb. 19th at the Ritz-Carlton, Kapalua, the artists will locate around the hotel grounds and Fleming Beach and paint for three hours, with the finished works to be displayed in our Village Gallery located off the lobby and on easels in the hallways.

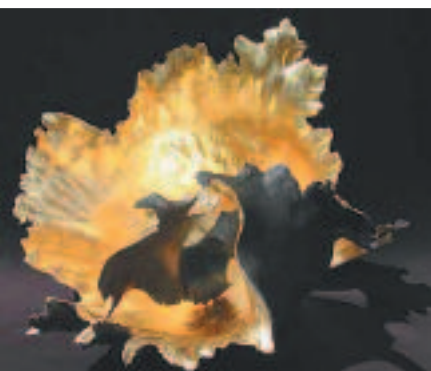

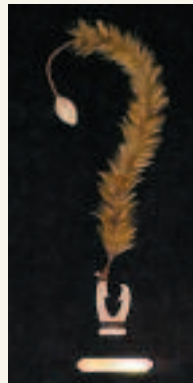
